How accessible is the UK iXBRL Viewer?

We launched the current version of the product for Public Beta phase on 15 January 2025. We know some of the iXBRL reports that are queried via the Companies House Registry or Financial Conduct Authority’s National Storage Mechanism to view in the product are not fully accessible, and this is outside the scope of the product as we do not wish to amend the filings.

Preparation of this accessibility statement

This statement was prepared on 15 December 2024. The accessibility test was carried out by our digital agency, Workiva using axe DevTools.

Workiva used a range of automated and manual methods to audit UK iXBRL Viewer:

- Keyboard navigation (Chrome)
- Full-page zoom (Chrome)
- Font-size zoom (Chrome)
- Other manual testing (Chrome)
- Accessibility Insights (Axe, Chrome)
- V.Nu HTML validator
- Pa11y (Axe / HTML CodeSniffer)
- High contrast mode (Chrome DevTools emulator)
- VoiceOver (macOS Safari)

Testing was carried out for all functionalities to ensure the results were representative of the whole product.
